

Triple Bunk Bed with Sliding Middle Bunk Assembly Instructions

Please read through the entire set of instructions before beginning assembly. Note the rails for the middle (slider) bed have 1/8" spacers attached to each end. The Middle Bunk is a separate bed that fits in-between the legs of the taller bunk bed to allow you to slide it as far out as needed to give the lower and middle people more vertical space at the head end.

First assemble the Ladder ends for each bed following the normal bunk bed procedures. Note the tall bed has one end with (4) rungs and the other with (3) rungs. The short bed has one end with (2) rungs and the other end has a 2x6 Header. Then install the upper rail and bed slats following the normal procedures. Then install the lower 3" rail on the floor and attach it to the legs with 2-1/2" screws. Install the bed slats into the lower rails following the normal procedures.

For the short bed, the end with (2) rungs needs to go on the outside of the bed. Install the (2) rails to the end with 2 rungs and then slide them through the inside of the legs at the end with (3) rungs on the tall bed. Now attach the rails to the short legs with the 2x6 header. Install the bed slats. Note the bed slats for the middle bunk are 1/4" shorter than the tall bunk slats. Turn the bed around if you need the slider to open on the right side.

Make sure you install (4) 2-1/2" screws around each carriage bolt from the back of the rail into the legs, this is very important to provide stability for the bed.
