Triple L-Shaped Bunk Bed Assembly Instructions

The Triple L-Shaped Bunk Bed is a standard Bunk Bed with Open-Ends and a Mid-Height Loft Bed which comes out perpendicular to the Bunk Bed.


We will send you a picture of your completed bed to be used as a guide for assembly.

The pictures shown on this set of instructions are sample pictures, your specific bed may be slightly different for the type and placement of the ladder and the position of the middle bunk. We recommend you first pre-assemble the bed with just the Carriage Bolts and a few screws to see how everything fits together and to make sure you have the proper orientation.

First assemble the **Bunk Bed** following the standard Beds with Open Ends assembly instructions. Please carefully note the front (long side) and back legs placement. You will receive (1) Notched L-Shaped Leg and (3) L-Shaped Legs. The legs will be labeled Front (long side) left & right and Back left & right. (1) front (long side) leg will be notched, this is the leg that the middle bunk will be attached to. Also note that the bottom 3" high rail rests on the floor.

Then assemble the **Mid-Height Loft Bed** following the same Beds with Open Ends assembly instructions. The difference is one rail and header are connected to the shared Bunk Bed Leg in the corner. You will receive (1) Notched L-Shape leg for the end under the bunk and (2) L-Shaped Legs for the end outside the bunk. See the following instructions.

The example shown below has a left middle bunk and has an Angled End Ladder for the Bunk Bed and a Vertical Front (long side) Ladder for the Mid-Height Loft Bed.



This shows an example of a right middle bunk.



Attach the Middle Bunk Rail & Safety Rails to the Bunk Bed Notched Leg.
