

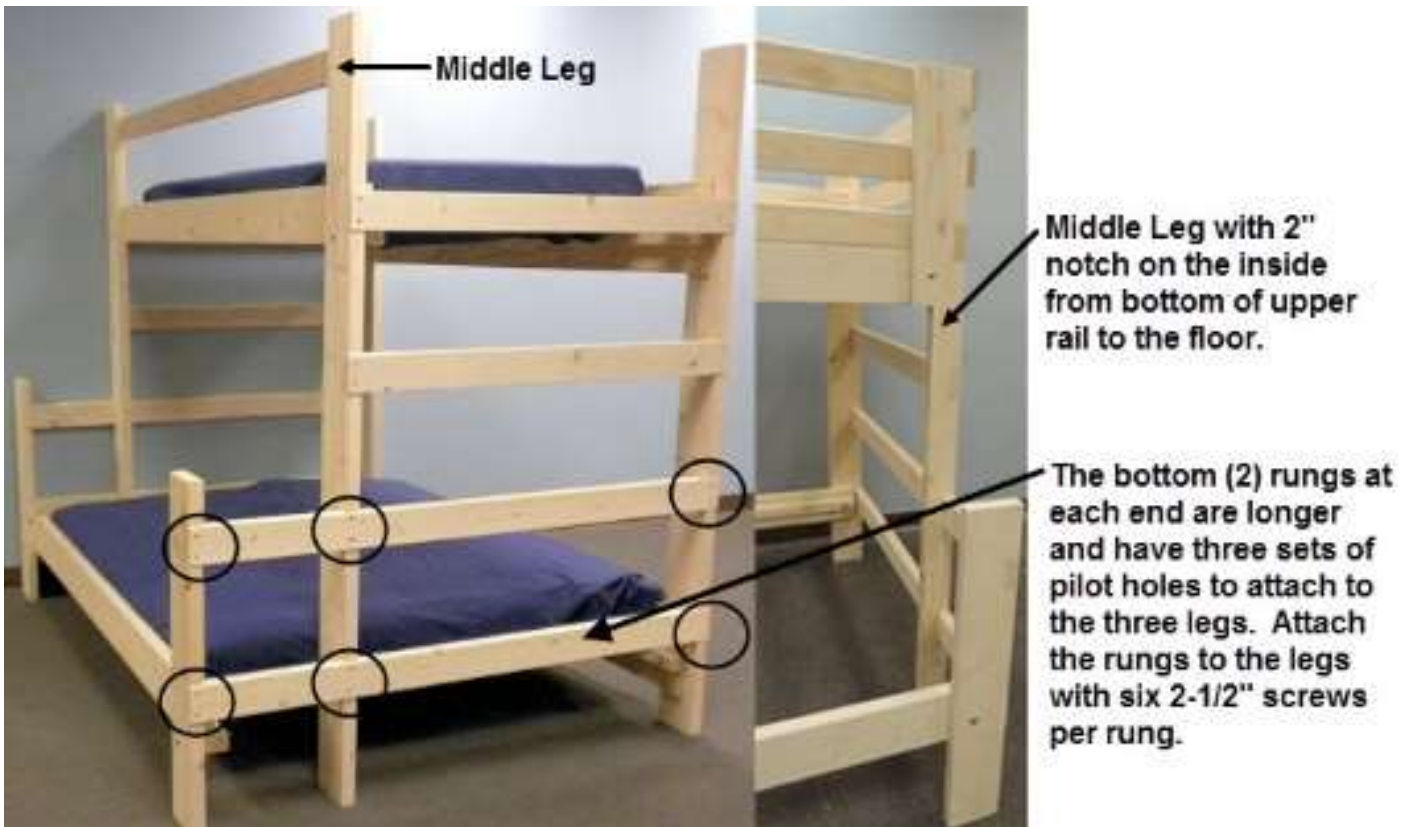
Twin/Full - Twin/Queen - Full/Queen Assembly Instructions

Bunk beds with different sizes above and below are basically assembled the same way with a few differences.

The bottom bunk has additional short legs at each end (see photo below).

The bottom (2) rungs are made longer for the larger size mattress below.

The middle legs will have a 2" notch going from the bottom of the upper rail to the floor. Depending on your configuration you will receive either (1) or (2) center legs with notches.



Angled Front Ladder Assembly Instructions



The optional Angled Front Ladder (AFL) may be attached to the left or right side.

To attach the AFL we add a second rail to the front lower bunk to clear the top of the mattress. This will be the base of the AFL. The Second Rail is attached exactly like the bottom rail using 4" carriage bolts and (8) 2-1/2" screws from the back of the rail into the leg. Attach the bottom of the AFL to the top of the Second Rail using (3) 2-1/2" screws. The top of the AFL is attached to the top rail from the behind the front rail into the 2x4 attached to the top of the AFL.

Attach the 2x6 Safety Rail Brace from the back of the rail into the Safety Rail Brace with (6) 2-1/2" screws. Now attach the safety rails using 1-5/8" screws.
